LAW REFORM COMMISSION OF SASKATCHEWAN**

The Director reports to the Law Reform Commission, an independent commission established by statute that meets quarterly and makes recommendations to the Minister of Justice for Saskatchewan. The Director is responsible for:

- conducting and supervising the legal research carried out by the Commission;
- writing its reports and papers;
- designing and implementing public consultations;
- preparing grant applications, budgets, and annual reports;
- general administration; and,
- maintaining the Commission's website.

Candidates must have:

- membership or qualification for membership in the Law Society of Saskatchewan;
- excellent research and analytical skills;
- excellent oral and written communication skills;
- ability to work independently.

The Director is a full time position. The Commission's office is at the College of Law, University of Saskatchewan in Saskatoon.

Applications must be received by July 4, 2014. Email of a single PDF is preferred.
